The Maharashtra State Common Entrance Test (CET) Cell, Mumbai, hereby informs all eligible candidates, participating Colleges and other concerned stakeholders that the CAP Round-II for admission to the LL.B. 3 Yrs. and LLB 5 Yrs. Integrated Programme for the Academic Year 2026-27 shall be conducted as per the schedules published on the official website of the CET Cell, and in accordance with the instructions given below. All candidates are advised to carefully read and understand the following instructions before participating in CAP Round-II.

Important Instructions for Candidates

A. Eligibility to Fill the College Option Form for CAP Round-II

(I) Candidates Eligible to Fill the College Option Form for CAP Round-II

The following candidates shall be eligible to fill the College Option Form for CAP Round-II:

- (1) Candidates who were not allotted any seat in CAP Round-I, subject to fulfilment of the prescribed eligibility conditions.
- (2) Candidates who were allotted a seat in CAP Round-I and have selected "Betterment" and completed the prescribed Seat Acceptance process, including payment of the Seat Acceptance Fee of ₹1,000/-.

(II) Candidates Not Eligible to Fill the College Option Form for CAP Round-II

The following candidates shall not be eligible to fill the College Option Form for CAP Round-II:

- (1) Candidates who were allotted a seat in CAP Round-I, selected "Freeze", paid the Seat Acceptance Fee of ₹1,000/- and completed the prescribed admission process at the allotted College. Such candidates shall not be considered for further CAP allotment.
- (2) Candidates who were allotted a seat in CAP Round-I, selected "Betterment" but failed to complete the prescribed Seat Acceptance process, including payment of the Seat Acceptance Fee of ₹1,000/-, within the stipulated period. Such candidates shall not be considered for Betterment in CAP Round-II. Their claim on the seat allotted in CAP

Round-I shall stand forfeited, and the seat shall be made available for fresh allotment in CAP Round-II.

B. College Option Form for CAP Round-II

- (1) Candidates who are eligible and willing to participate in CAP Round-II may revise their College preferences by submitting a fresh College Option Form through their Candidate Login.
- (2) Candidates who do not submit a revised College Option Form for CAP Round-II shall be considered on the basis of the preferences submitted by them in the previous CAP Round. Such preferences shall be carried forward for CAP Round-II.
- (3) Where a candidate submits a revised College Option Form for CAP Round-II, only the preferences submitted in the revised Option Form shall be considered for CAP Round-II, and the preferences submitted in the previous CAP Round shall not be considered.
- (4) Candidates shall enter their College preferences in the order of their preference, with the College in which they are most interested being placed at the highest preference.
- (5) Candidates are advised to carefully verify the list of participating Colleges, courses, intake, category-wise seats and other relevant information before submitting the College Option Form.
- (6) Mere submission of the College Option Form shall not confer any right upon the candidate to allotment of a particular College or seat. Allotment shall be made on the basis of merit, category, applicable reservation, availability of seats and preferences submitted by the candidate, subject to the applicable rules.

C. Candidates Allotted a Seat in CAP Round-II

(I) Candidates allotted a seat for the first time in CAP Round-II

Candidates who are allotted a seat for the first time in CAP Round-II shall have the following two options:

- (1) Freeze: The candidate may select "Freeze", pay the Seat Acceptance Fee of ₹1,000/-, and report to the allotted College within the prescribed schedule to complete the admission process; or
- (2) Betterment: The candidate may select "Betterment", pay the Seat Acceptance Fee of ₹1,000/-, and participate in CAP Round-III for further betterment, subject to the applicable rules.

(II) Candidates allotted a better preference in CAP Round-II

Candidates who were allotted a seat in CAP Round-I and are allotted a better preference in CAP Round-II shall not be required to pay the Seat Acceptance Fee of ₹1,000/- again. Such candidates shall have the following two options:

- (1) Freeze: The candidate may select "Freeze" and report to the allotted College within the prescribed schedule to complete the admission process; or
- (2) Betterment: The candidate may select "Betterment" and participate in CAP Round-III for further betterment, subject to the applicable rules.

Note: On allotment of a better preference in CAP Round-II, the candidate's claim on the previously allotted seat shall cease, and that seat shall be made available for fresh allotment to other eligible candidates as per the applicable CAP rules.

(III) Candidates not allotted a better preference in CAP Round-II

Candidates who were allotted a seat in CAP Round-I and do not receive a better preference in CAP Round-II may either:

- (1) Freeze the previously allotted seat and report to the concerned College within the prescribed schedule to complete the admission process; or
- (2) Select "Betterment" and participate in CAP Round-III, subject to the applicable rules.

Note: Such candidates shall not be required to pay the Seat Acceptance Fee of ₹1,000/- again.

D. Category Change in CAP Round-III

- (1) Candidates who, while filling the College Option Form for CAP Round-III, change their category from Open to Reserved or from Reserved to Open, as applicable, shall forfeit their claim on the seat allotted to them in CAP Round-I and/or CAP Round-II.
- (2) Such candidates shall be considered for fresh seat allotment in CAP Round-III on the basis of the category declared by them and the preferences submitted in the CAP Round-III College Option Form, subject to the applicable rules and availability of seats.

E. Document Verification and Admission Confirmation

- (1) Candidates allotted a seat in CAP Round-II shall report to the allotted College within the prescribed period for document verification and confirmation of admission.
- (2) Candidates shall carry all required original documents along with the necessary copies, as applicable.
- (3) The admitting College shall verify the documents furnished by the candidate in the CAP Application Form and the documents required for admission.
- (4) Colleges shall not verify the details filled in the CET Application Form or insist upon submission of the CET Hall Ticket for admission.
- (5) If the original SSC/HSC Mark Sheet or Passing Certificate is not available at the time of admission, admission may be granted on submission of either the Mark Sheet or Passing Certificate, along with an undertaking from the candidate to submit the original or duplicate copy of the document not submitted at the time of admission within 15 days.
- (6) Candidates whose Final Year Degree Mark Sheet is not yet available may be admitted on the basis of an Office Record Copy/Mark Memo/Online Result (Gazette Copy) showing subject-wise and total marks, duly endorsed by the Principal/Competent Authority. The original Final Year Degree Mark Sheet, if available, shall be submitted and uploaded at the time of admission; otherwise, it shall be submitted and uploaded on or before the last date of CAP Round-III.

- (7) If the First Year and Second Year marks and percentages are mentioned on the Final Year Degree Mark Sheet, the College shall not insist upon separate First Year and Second Year Mark Sheets.
- (8) ICSE/CBSE Board candidates who have reported marks for 5 or 6 subjects, as applicable, shall be considered for admission and shall not be rejected on this ground.

F. Candidates belonging to Reserved Categories

- (1) Candidates belonging to a reserved category must have claimed the respective category in their online CAP registration form for Maharashtra State quota seats. Candidates admitted against reserved category seats shall be required to submit the requisite original certificates, as applicable, namely Caste Validity Certificate (CVC), Tribe Validity Certificate (TVC), Non-Creamy Layer (NCL) Certificate and EWS Certificate.
- (2) Candidates belonging to VJ/DT(A), NT(B), NT(C), NT(D), OBC (including SBC) and SEBC categories shall submit a Non-Creamy Layer Certificate valid up to 31st March 2027, wherever applicable.
- (3) Where a candidate has applied for the requisite CVC/TVC/NCL/EWS Certificate and has submitted the application receipt, admission may be granted provisionally on the basis of such receipt. Candidates admitted in CAP Round I or II on the basis of an application receipt shall submit and upload the requisite original certificate through their candidate login on or before the last date of CAP Round III.
- (4) Candidates belonging to the OBC and SEBC categories who have submitted the application receipt for their Caste Validity Certificate shall upload the original Caste Validity Certificate through their candidate login within the timeline prescribed in G.R. No. संकीर्ण-2024/प्र.क्र.75 (भाग-1)/आरक्षण-5, dated 02/07/2026, issued by the General Administration Department (GAD).
- (5) If a candidate (except OBC and SEBC candidate) fails to submit and upload the requisite original certificate on or before the last date of CAP Round III, the admitting college shall cancel the admission through its login/online system. Thereafter, such candidate may apply in the Institutional Round under the Open Category, subject to fulfilment of the applicable eligibility requirements, rules and availability of seats.

Important Instructions for Admitting Colleges

- (1) All participating Colleges shall strictly follow the schedule declared by the State CET Cell.
- (2) Colleges shall verify the candidate's documents and confirm admission only after completion of the prescribed Seat Acceptance process.
- (3) Colleges shall not insist upon verification of the CET Application Form or submission of the CET Hall Ticket.
- (4) Colleges shall upload the details of admitted candidates on the CAP Portal within the prescribed period.

- (5) Colleges shall ensure that the information uploaded on the Portal is accurate and corresponds with the documents verified at the time of admission.
- (6) Colleges shall not deny admission to an eligible candidate merely on account of non-availability of an original document where admission is specifically permitted against the prescribed undertaking/application receipt, subject to the conditions mentioned in this Notice.
- (7) Colleges shall ensure compliance with the prescribed timeline for uploading admitted candidate data and shall be responsible for completing the online admission confirmation process within the stipulated period.
